The Colorado Springs (COS), Colorado Chapter of MOWW, was pleased to welcome District Attorney Michael Allen as our guest speaker at our 16 March 2024 Membership meeting. DA Allen has served in the Colorado 4th Judicial District Attorney's Office since 2011 and was named the Homicide Prosecutor of the Year in both 2015 and 2017. In January 2021, he was elected as District Attorney of the 4th Judicial District which serves over 1 Million Colorado citizens in Teller and El Paso Counties. DA Allen provided rare insights into his two most prominent cases over the past year – the murder of Gannon Stauch by his Stepmother and the mass killing of five individuals at Club Q, an LGBTQ safe haven. Both of these cases received national attention and DA Allen prosecuted them personally, securing life sentences without parole for each of the perpetrators. We are grateful to DA Michael Allen for his leadership and for representing all of us within the 4th Judicial District.
